Support from the Kinder- und Jugendhilfe welfare service

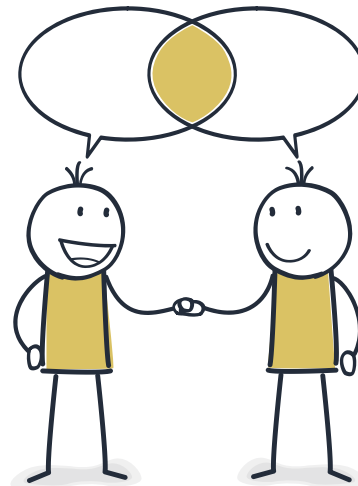
- You'll find them where they're needed. The support worker **comes to your home** or accompanies you on errands – e.g. to an office or to a talk at school.
- The type of support depends on **individual needs**. Counselling sessions are available as well as **practical help in everyday life** or activities with the children.
- Your rights as parents are not restricted. The aim of the support is to **find good solutions together** with everyone involved.
- The service **is free** for you to avail of.

More information is available under It's a suitable possibility for you...

- if you no longer feel you can handle the demands of everyday family life.
- if your child is facing difficult issues and family support isn't enough.
- if you don't know exactly how to behave in some parenting situations and feel overwhelmed.
- if your family is in a crisis situation.
- if you, as a young person, are not coping with your current life situation and would like to have an adult contact person outside the family.

And here's how it works...

- You, as the legal guardian, decide together with the Kinder- und Jugendhilfe welfare service whether support should be arranged.
- If yes, a suitable and specially trained support worker is appointed.
- The content and goals of the support will be discussed with you and determined together.
- The support worker informs the Kinder- und Jugendhilfe welfare service at regular intervals about the progress of the support.
- Support is ended in consultation with everyone involved as soon as essential goals have been achieved.
